WHO WE ARE:

Since 1985, Asociación Emergencia Ayacucho (AEA) has supported and enabled care for more than 1,800 underprivileged children from Ayacucho who have received the proper education, basic care, psychological support and inspiration to become upstanding citizens of Ayacucho. In 1987, AEA started a chapter in Miami, Florida.

Currently, AEA supports three orphanages in Ayacucho located in the districts of Huanta, Huancapi and Vilcashuamán. Each home has capacity to care for approximately 30 children.

When the children graduate from high school from any of the orphan homes, they are offered to live in a youth home, one for men and one for women, located in Huamanga. The Youth Homes are designed to teach young people the skills and confidence to live independently, and enable them to continue their education through scholarships funded by AEA to local technical schools. Each youth home accommodates up to 18 people.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

AEA believes in the power of education, and has, therefore, created two scholarship awards, each one of \$1,500 to two deserving male or female Miami-Dade County Public Schools high school seniors matriculating at an accredited four-year college or university for the Fall 2022 academic year. Because education and caring for one's community is part of AEA Miami's mission, special consideration will be given to applicant's interest in education and civic service, as demonstrated by their personal essay.

ELIGIBILITY – THE APPLICANT MUST:

- Demonstrate financial need to pay for college during 2022 school year
- Be a graduate from a Miami-Dade County Public High School in 2021-2022 school year
- Have been accepted to/or been enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university
- Enroll full-time (12-18 credits), seeking a degree at a post-secondary institution
- Use the AEA Miami scholarship only for a post-secondary institution named in the application
- Be a US citizen or legal resident based in South Florida.
- Be available for a personal interview
- Include a senior yearbook photo or head shot in professional attire with the application
- Demonstrate ambition and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community or work-related activities
- Complete application available online at www.AEAMiami.com/scholarship by July 15, 2022. No information will be accepted by email, mail or fax. If an application is missing information or attachments, AEA Miami will NOT inform the applicant.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- Completed application (typed) and Parent/Guardian signature
- Official high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation from a School Representative, Community Leader, or Civic Leader. The letters must discuss the applicant's leadership experience, community service involvement, character, and scholastic achievement.
- Proof of a minimum of 50 community service hours documented on the high school transcript or on an official letterhead from the service organization with an original signature
- PDF Copy of official SAT or ACT Test scores
- FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) - upload all pages as a single document
- Personal Essay (typed, one page, plain legible font, and double spaced) discussing one of the following:
 - o Who is someone that you admire and why?
 - o Who is the most important person in your life?
 - o What is one personal or professional goal you strive for within the next ten years?
 - o What local, national, or international event or issue has made an impact on you, and how?

REMINDER: Carefully review the application guidelines for details about each attachment. All required attachments must be uploaded as a single document. PDF and JPEG formats are the only formats allowed. For documents with multiple pages, you must combine them into a single document before they can be uploaded.

NOTE: Only completed applications, postmarked by Sunday, July 15, 2022, will be processed (NO EXCEPTIONS).

- The location and time of any one-on-one interviews will be scheduled directly with each candidate.
- The applicant must provide AEA with an official proof of enrollment letter or memo signed by a school official for the Fall of 2022 on or before September 1, 2022 **or the award will be forfeited.**
- Scholarship recipients are selected and payments are remitted directly to the institution and/or the award recipient at the sole discretion of Association Emergencia Ayacucho.
- Upload the application and all supporting documents in one packet on or before Sunday, July 15, 2022 to Asociación Emergencia Ayacucho at www.aeamiamichapter.com
